

THE MOULIN DE LA VISTE

Welcome to The Moulin de la Viste

Enjoy a restful vacation in romantic Provence in a 300-year old stone mill with a secluded salt-water swimming pool for totally private bathing. Moulin de la Viste is a 18th century Provençal olive mill on a hillside along a babbling brook. Built in 1776, it is as old as the United States of America. The property is fully fenced, faces south and is surrounded by wooded hills, olive groves and vineyards.

The house is fully equipped for year-round living. There is central heating, satellite TV, wifi high-speed Internet access, a stereo and a washing machine. The kitchen has a dishwasher, an ice-box-freezer, a convection-microwave oven and direct access to the patio.

Linen and weekly cleaning is included in the rental price.

Thick stone walls keep it pleasantly cool even during summer heat. In the living room the ceiling is up to 6 meters high!

All rooms are very light, airy, with high beamed ceilings, arranged around a patio which still contains the original mill stones and fixtures. The furniture is attractive and simple, in keeping with the ancient walls.

The master bedroom, opening on to the patio, has a double bed. Its bathroom has a Jacuzzi bathtub and a heated towel rack. The second bedroom is on the first floor and has two twin beds that can be pushed together to make one king-size bed. It has its own shower room and a separate toilet on the floor below.

A tree-shaded terrace above the Riou de Claviers has two Weber barbecues and is furnished for eating outdoors.

This is Provence that has managed to remain more or less true to itself and is well worth a trip. Claviers is an unspoiled village which has not been torted up, yet. It has a 12 century chapel, many medieval houses, picturesque lanes and friendly villagers. We have a café, two restaurants, a baker, a small grocery and a tourism office.

There are many wonderful walks in and around Claviers and right outside the Moulin de la Viste. A car is necessary to get around although the village can be reached by a steep uphill path in about 1/2 hour.

The Moulin de la Viste is located in the village of Claviers, in Provence.
Claviers is about 60 kms from Saint-Tropez and 20 kms from Draguignan.

Activities

There is pétanque in the village, horse-back riding, golf, water sports, interesting places to visit. The Nice international airport is one hour away, St. Tropez and the beaches three quarters of an hour. The famous Gorges du Verdon are not far and the Gorges de Pennafort are near-by and are lit at night.

The villages of Bargemon, Seillans, Fayence are all worth a visit. In the summer there are many concerts, especially the music festival in Callas.

DESCRIPTION

Bedroom n°1

This double bedroom is on the ground floor and has access to the patio.
Its bathroom has a Jacuzzi and a heated towel rack.

Bedroom n°2

The twin beds in the upstairs bedroom can be pushed together to make a king-size double bed. A shower room with a washing machine is on the same landing and a separate toilet on the ground floor below.

Kitchen

Enjoy your holiday in the south of France with a fully equipped kitchen-dining room, dishwasher, convection-microwave oven and icebox-freezer.

Living Room

Simply but tastefully furnished, this old house in Provence is very light and airy, with high beamed ceilings and rooms arranged around a glassed-in patio open to the sky and displaying some of the original working machinery and mill grinding stones.

Thick stone walls keep rooms pleasantly cool, even during hot weather.

Patio

The patio used to be the heart of the working mill. Its north wall has three niches where huge presses were once housed.

Swimming Pool

The salt water in the pool is good for the skin. Enjoy lying on comfortable mattresses in the shade or in the sun.

Terrace

A shaded eating area in front of the house. There are two Weber barbecues as well.
